

Attention All Trail Riders,

I have great concern about the outcome of the Cave Run Trail Initiative meetings. It looks like the Forest Service has plans to close the Caney Trail #1226. This is the trail that follows along the lake shore that connects White Sulfur Horse Camp to the dam at Stoney Cove on Cave Run Lake.

This trail has a long history of horse use, and is one of the most popular. It is also one half of the loop known as the Caney Loop, the other half being the Sheltowee Trail.

The Forest Service has made a proposal to close this trail to horses. This summer, they will be doing an environmental analysis on this area. The team leader for this project is Patty Beyer ([pbeyer@fs.fed.us](mailto:pbeyer@fs.fed.us)). The information from this project, plus the public input will decide the fate of this trail.
